BACKGROUND to possible National Association

- National government established the South African Precinct Management Initiative (SAPMI) to address precinct management policy and legislation gaps and **requested the precinct management industry to associate on a national basis in order to represent the precinct management industry on SAPMI**
- Treasury & SAPOA agreed on MoU that included working together on Precinct/Urban Management matters. JHB & Mpumalanga CID Forums entered into a back-to-back MOU with SAPOA. Raised funding + SAPOA Corporates to appoint David van Niekerk to facilitate the establishment of a National Precinct Management Association
- While various stakeholders in the precinct management industry and in the public sector recognise the need for the establishment of a National Association. The benefits of such an Association, over and above the benefits provided by local structures, are however not clear to all stakeholders nationally.

SAPOA M.O.U PURPOSE AND DELIVERABLES

To facilitate the process towards the establishment of a National Association for Managed Precincts via the following deliverables:

- Principles that underpin the establishment of a National Association
- Unique benefits/value proposition of the Association
- A constitution for the national association of managed precincts
- Convene the first meeting of the association

Deliverable Criteria

- Draw on local and international good practice and alignment to the South African context
- Quality above quantity
- Draw on the insights and involvement of key stakeholders related to the SA Precinct Management Industry
- Package as a deliverable fit for the use by the future association

JULY 2019 - SYMPOSIUMS AIMS

- Identifying Precinct Management good practise from the UK, USA, Canadian and local case studies
- Exploring the value proposition for the establishment of a new national Precinct Management Association; and
- Establishing research , training and education needs for South African Precinct Management Practitioners
